Talk with your child about the names of the animals and plants you see. Check out your library for books about native plants and animals in your area.

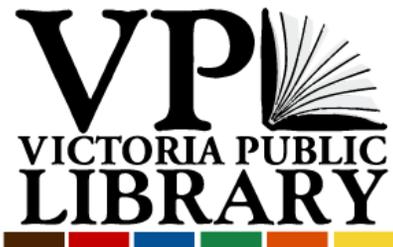
Read a non-fiction book.


Play pretend!
