Identifying shapes is a precursor to learning letters. Have your child play with different shape blocks or go on a shape scavenger hunt around your house.

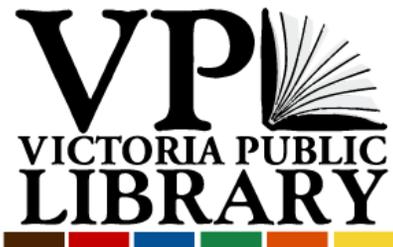
Learn new words through music!

Help your child build their vocabulary with songs. Sing a song you remember learning as a child. A song that was special to you can become special to your child too!


Try recorded books.


